REGARDING NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000,000 SOUTH CAROLINA JOBS-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES REVENUE BONDS (MYCOWORKS PROJECT)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and Title 41, Chapter 43 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, as amended, the South Carolina Jobs-Economic Development Authority ("Authority") will hold a public hearing ("Public Hearing") **commencing at 11:00 AM, or as soon thereafter as may be heard following other public hearings, on June 5, 2025, and will be held telephonically by the Authority**, regarding the issuance by the Authority of its Environmental Facilities Revenue Bonds (MycoWorks Project) in one or more taxable or tax-exempt series as part of a plan for financing the Project (defined below) in a maximum aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$90,000,000 (collectively, "Bonds").

The Authority will loan the proceeds of the Bonds ("Loan") to MycoWorks SC, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Borrower"). The Borrower intends to use the proceeds of the Bonds to (i) finance a portion of the costs of the acquisition, design, construction, improvement, and equipping of a solid waste disposal facility ("Facility") in Union County, South Carolina ("County"), (ii) fund certain reserve accounts and funds related to the Facility and the Bonds, (iii) finance interest on the Bonds, and (iv) pay certain fees and expenses to be incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds (collectively, (i), (ii), (iii), and (iv), "Project").

The Facility is owned and operated by the Borrower and is located at 260 Midway Drive, Union, South Carolina 29379 in the County.

The Bonds, when issued, will be special, limited obligations of the Authority payable solely out of the revenues derived from the repayment of the Loan by the Borrower. The Bonds will not constitute a general obligation or indebtedness of the Authority, the State of South Carolina ("State") or any other governmental entity within the meaning of any state constitutional provisions (other than indebtedness payable only from a revenue-producing project or special source within the meaning of Article X, Section 13(9) of the Constitution of the State, 1895, as amended) or statutory limitation nor give rise to a pecuniary liability of the Authority or the State. The Bonds will not constitute a charge against the general credit of the Authority or the State or the taxing powers of the State. The Authority has no taxing powers.

The Public Hearing will be conducted telephonically.
